Norwegian Foreign Minister Informs U. S. Envoy To Norway That Nation Is At War With Germany Following Attempted Entrance Of Four Nazi Warships Into Oslo Fjord And Attack From Air—Official Announcement.

Scapa Flow Again Raided; Allies Firm On Mine Use

German Planes Drop Incendiary and High Explosive Bombs On Naval Base—Three Craft Shot Down—Allies Are Defiant Over Mine-Laying Despite Protests.

LONDON, April 9 (AP)—(Tuesday)—German warplanes dropped incendiary and high explosive bombs in their third raid within a month last night on Britain's Scapa Flow naval base, the air ministry reported early today. At least two German planes were shot down, the British said, and a third was believed brought down before the attack ended.
