Day and Night Sessions Ordered; Molotov, Eden May Have To Leave

SAN FRANCISCO, May 1.—(AP)—The United Nations conference ordered day and night sessions today, trying to catch up on as much detail as possible before Soviet Foreign Minister Molotov must return to Moscow to tackle problems of war. It was learned the commissioner might have to leave any day.

A meeting last night of foreign secretaries of the big-four nations sponsoring the conference was largely devoted to the business of setting up the four commissions and dozen committees which will do the actual work intended to guarantee world security.
